Salmon Bento \$8.25

- Sake Teriyaki Bento* - Salmon Teriyaki
- Shio Sake Bento – Lightly salted sake
- Sake Tamago Toji Bento – Salmon and onion smothered in cooked egg
- Sake Fry Bento – Deep fried salmon

Chicken Bento \$7.50

- Tori Teriyaki Bento*- Chicken Teriyaki
- Tori Piiman Bento* – Sautéed with chicken and red pepper
- Oyako Bento – Chicken and onion smothered in cooked egg

Beef Bento \$7.50

- Gyu Teriyaki Bento* - Beef Teriyaki
- Sukiyaki Bento – Sliced beef, veggies, and tofu sukiyaki
- Gyu piiman Bento* - Marinated beef with red pepper

Pork Bento \$7.50

- Buta Teriyaki Bento* - Pork Teriyaki
- Buta Piman* - Sautéed Pork with red pepper
- Tanin Bento – Pork and onion smothered in cooked egg

All entrees are served with miso soup and five country side dishes. Your choice of brown rice or white rice with barley.

Bento is the Japanese word for a boxed meal to go.

Vegetarian Bento \$6.85

- Iridofu Bento – Scrambled tofu, wakame, shitake mushrooms, soybeans and carrots with a light miso taste
- Saishoku Bento – Domo's original country side dish sampler

Curry Bento \$7.75

- Chicken Curry Bento – Chicken Curry
- Pork Curry Bento – Pork Curry
- Beef Curry Bento – Beef Curry

Unagi Bento \$9.50

- Unagi Teriyaki Bento – Unagi Teriyaki
- Unagi Omuretsu Bento – Omelet style Unagi Teriyaki
- Unagi Toji Bento - Unagi and onion smothered in cooked egg

Yakisoba \$8.25

- Chicken Yakisoba* - Sauteed Ramen noodles with vegetables and chicken
- Pork Yakisoba * - Sauteed Ramen noodles with vegetables and pork
- Beef Yakisoba* - Sauteed Ramen noodles with vegetables and beef
- Shrimp Yakisoba* - Sauteed Ramen noodles with vegetables and shrimp
