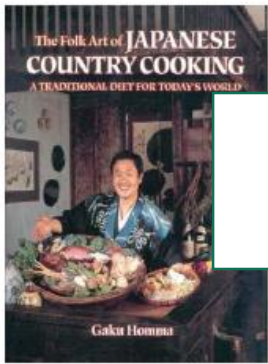
Choice of meat or fish smothered with egg
